The stuff that prevents us from doing what we really want to be doing. That prevents us from becoming who we really want to become.

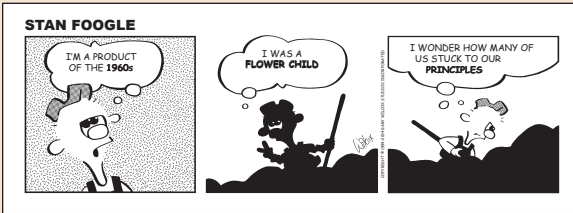
Stan is mired in so much of this "stuff" that he wears hip waders and carries a shovel.

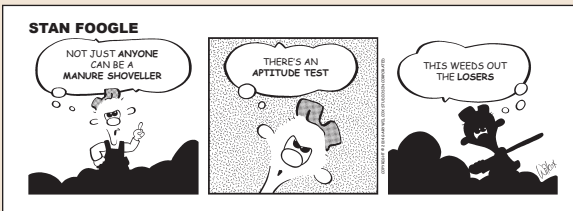
Perhaps the best way to understand Stan Foogle is to walk a mile in his hip waders...



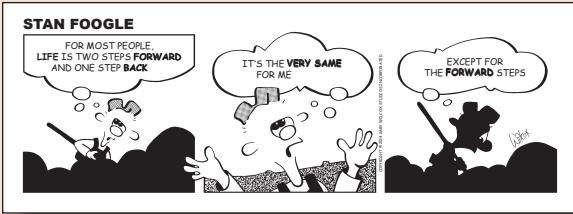

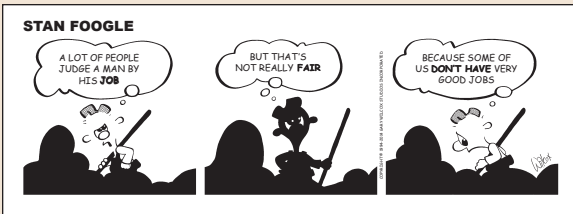

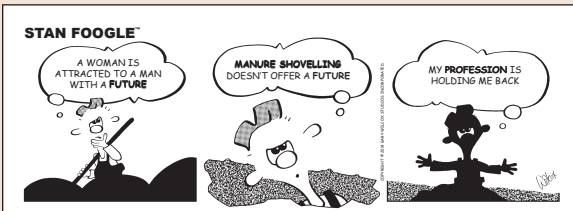
Although a manure shoveller,

than anyone else . . .



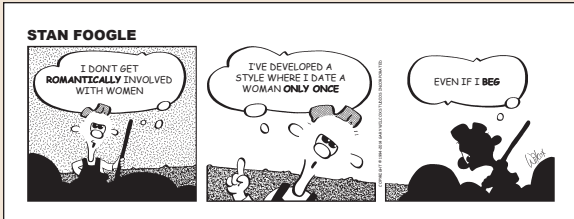

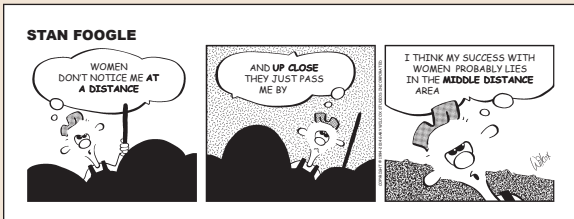

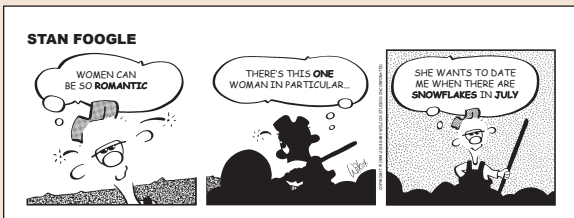
